On March 13, 2009, thirty-nine year old Grass Valley native Tristan Anderson was shot in the head at close range with a high-velocity tear gas grenade by the Israeli border police. Tristan was taking photos following a demonstration against the apartheid wall in the West Bank village of Ni'lin when the incident occurred. The shooting caused severe traumatic brain injury and blindness in his right eye. Tristan has not yet regained the use of the left side of his body. He remains in a wheelchair and faces a long period of physical and cognitive rehabilitation.
